



# MY TRIP TO SEE WESTS TIGERS AT COMMBANK STADIUM







I can catch a train to Parramatta train Station and walk to the stadium.

CommBank Stadium is a 20 minute walk from the station.

I will walk to Gate F to access the stadium

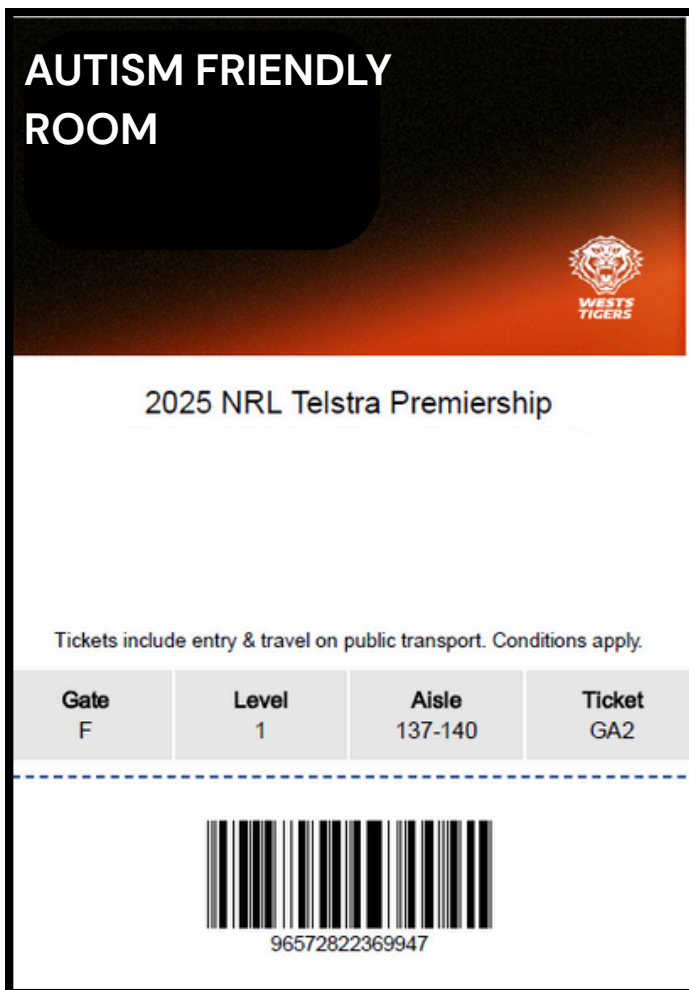


GATE F is located on the western side of the stadium near the Western Carpark

I will show my ticket at the GATE

Make sure I have my ticket ready to go to scan

If I have a bag, the security guard may ask me to have a look inside, to make sure it's safe to bring inside to the stadium.

I will walk on the right side past the  
Elevators

When I see the room that says  
Function Room 1,  
I am in the right place.

It is important that I stay with my  
parent and listen to stadium staff  
as this area can get very busy

## WESTS TIGERS MATCH DAY : MY VISUAL STORY





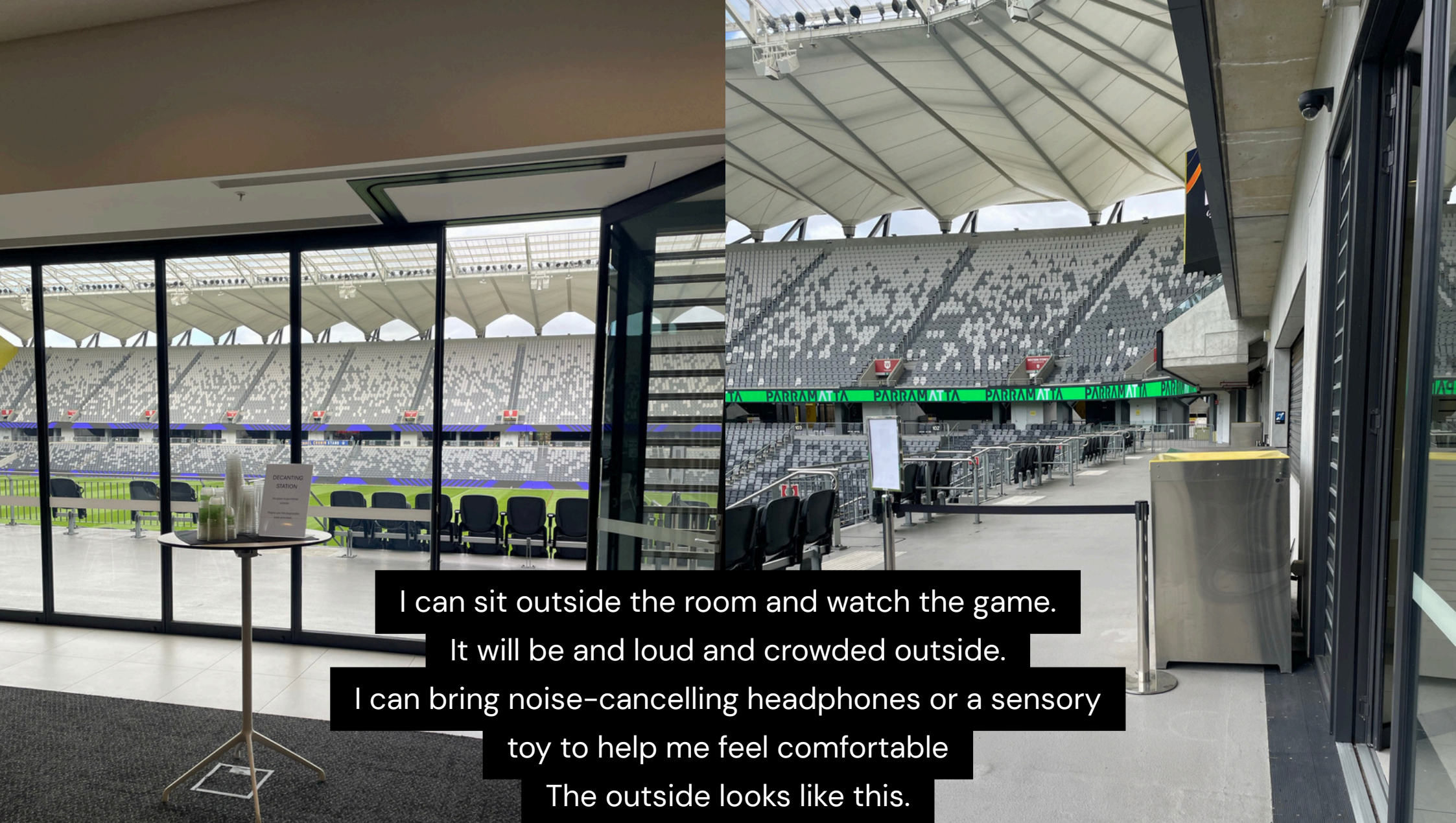
The nearest toilet is just outside the
