Grassroots to Greatness Competition
Terms and Conditions – Game of Skill

PROMOTERS' DETAILS

- This competition is being run by **Zurich Financial Services Australia Limited** (ABN 11 008 423 372) 118 Mount St, North Sydney NSW 2060 (**Zurich**) in conjunction with **West's Tigers Rugby League Football Pty Ltd** (ABN 49 090 076 403) Zurich Centre, Loftus St Concord, NSW 2137 (**West Tigers**).
- For the purpose of these terms and conditions, both Zurich and West's Tigers may be collectively referred to as the (**Promoters**).

ELIGIBLE ENTRANTS

- To enter this competition, an entrant must meet the requirements set out below.
- An individual (**Eligible Entrant**) may enter on behalf of their Community junior team sporting organisation that participate in a local Australian Rugby League competition across Australia (**Clubs**).
- An Eligible Entrant must:
 - be over the age of 18 years at the date of entering the competition, or have permission from their parent or legal guardian to enter;
 - must reside in Australia; and
 - not be staff of Zurich and West's Tigers; or an immediate family member.
- A limit of one entry, per Club to the competition applies. In the case of multiple entries from a Club being received, the first entry received only will be considered.

HOW TO ENTER

- The competition period commences at 3:00pm AEDST on 20/06/23 and ends at 11.59pm 1/10/23 (**competition period**), and the Promoters reserve the right to extend the competition period at any time (subject to regulatory approval, if required).

- Included within the competition page is a requirement to fill in a 50 word or less answer as to why your Club best deserves the Grassroots to Greatness training pack.
- Eligible Entrants must fill in their full name, Junior Club name, contact number, email address, and state as a requirement as this information will be used as contact details for all successful recipients for the Grassroots to Greatness training pack.
- No late entries will be accepted.
- Incomplete, indecipherable, or illegible entries will be deemed invalid and may be rejected. The Promoters reserves the right to disqualify any entry where it reasonably suspects that such materials are prohibited by these terms and conditions, any relevant law, or are otherwise deemed inappropriate. This is at the Promoters' absolute discretion.

SELECTION OF WINNER

- One Club will be selected for each try scored by the Wests Tigers NRLW team during the 2023 NRLW home and away season.
- This competition is a game of skill.
- Winners will be chosen by a judging panel selected by the Promoters.
- Judges will review each eligible entry on the originality, authenticity, and creativity of the 50 word or less answer provided as part of the competition form.
- The judging panel will review all entrants on weekly basis during the competition period.
- The winners will be notified by email or telephone by Wests Tigers.
- The winners will be asked to provide a contact name and postal address for the Junior Rugby League Club that they have nominated, so that their prize pack can be mailed to them.
- The results of the draw will be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into in relation to the results of the judges' decision.

SECOND CHANCE DRAW

- If a winner does not respond within 7 days of being notified that they have won one of the Grassroots to Greatness training packs and reasonable efforts have been made by the Promoters to contact the winner, then the winner will automatically forfeit their prize and the Promoters reserve the right to select an alternative winner from existing entrants.

PROMOTION AND MARKETING

- By entering the competition, the winner agrees to participate in such promotional activity and material as the Promoter may require without remuneration.
